The most southern inhabited place in Canada and an amazing hot spot for *Carolinian Biodiversity!* It is a designated *Important Bird Area* & a candidate *Key Biodiversity Area*. The island is on a major flyway for migrating birds, butterflies & dragonflies, spring & fall. It is home to species of plants, salamanders, snakes, snails & other creatures that occur nowhere else in Canada!
